## ADMISSION POLICY

- The college is a Jain Religious Minority college, administered under the provisions of the Indian Constitution, to promote the welfare of the Minority community.
- As per the Judgement dated 12<sup>th</sup> October 2017 of the Honourable Bombay High Court vide wrt Petition No.1726 of 2001, Minority Colleges do not need to set aside seats for Backward Classes. This is reiterated by the University of Mumbai Circular (No.Aff./Recog./Admission/(2018-19)/10/of 2018), dated 30th May 2018.
- 15% Management Quota will be applicable to all the colleges including Minority Colleges as per University Circular Number Spl. Cell/(68)/2018/2005 dated 3<sup>rd</sup> June, 2005.
- Out of other remaining seats, 50% seats will be allotted to minority and 50% seats will be allotted to open category. For both the categories, In house students will be admitted first. The remaining seats will be given to the outsiders.
- The college conducts admissions for UG and PG programmes every year in a well-structured and transparent manner.
- Admission is open to all eligible candidate from anywhere in India and abroad.
- The Admission activities of the college are regulated and supervised by the Principal and the Admission committee
- Applications for admissions are to be submitted online using the Online Application facility on the college website

- Online submission of Application forms, announcement of Merit list and actual admission along with payment of fees and submission of documents will be carried out as per University of Mumbai circular of the relevant year
